

1 Overall quality at a glance (i)

The red, orange, yellow and green segments of the lower bar indicate the fraction of residues that contain outliers for >=3, 2, 1 and 0 types of geometric quality criteria respectively. A grey segment represents the fraction of residues that are not modelled. The numeric value for each fraction is indicated below the corresponding segment, with a dot representing fractions <=5%

2 Entry composition (i)

There are 4 unique types of molecules in this entry. The entry contains 5026 atoms, of which 0 are hydrogens and 0 are deuteriums.





3 Residue-property plots (i)

These plots are drawn for all protein, RNA, DNA and oligosaccharide chains in the entry. The first graphic for a chain summarises the proportions of the various outlier classes displayed in the second graphic. The second graphic shows the sequence view annotated by issues in geometry. Residues are color-coded according to the number of geometric quality criteria for which they contain at least one outlier: green = 0, yellow = 1, orange = 2 and red = 3 or more. Stretches of 2 or more consecutive residues without any outlier are shown as a green connector. Residues present in the sample, but not in the model, are shown in grey.

Xtriage's analysis on translational NCS is as follows: The largest off-origin peak in the Patterson function is 3.68% of the height of the origin peak. No significant pseudotranslation is detected.

5.2 Too-close contacts (i)
