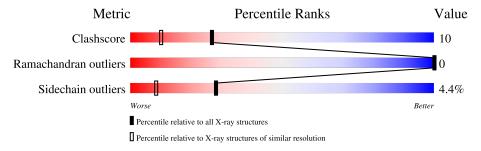

1 Overall quality at a glance (i)

2 Entry composition (i)

There are 4 unique types of molecules in this entry. The entry contains 1356 atoms, of which 0 are hydrogens and 0 are deuteriums.

In the tables below, the ZeroOcc column contains the number of atoms modelled with zero occupancy, the AltConf column contains the number of residues with at least one atom in alternate conformation and the Trace column contains the number of residues modelled with at most 2 atoms.

• Molecule 1 is a protein called ATP-dependent Clp protease ATP-binding subunit ClpC1.

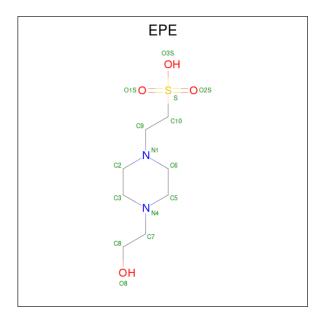

Xtriage's analysis on translational NCS is as follows: The largest off-origin peak in the Patterson function is 9.65% of the height of the origin peak. No significant pseudotranslation is detected.

4.1 Standard geometry (i)

4.2 Too-close contacts (i)
