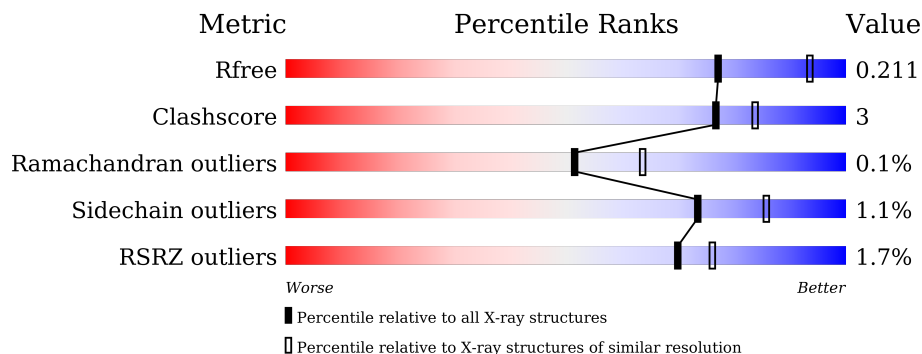
1 Overall quality at a glance

The following experimental techniques were used to determine the structure:

X-RAY DIFFRACTION

The reported resolution of this entry is 2.30 Å.

Percentile scores (ranging between 0-100) for global validation metrics of the entry are shown in the following graphic. The table shows the number of entries on which the scores are based.

A grey segment represents the fraction of residues that are not modelled. The numeric value for each fraction is indicated below the corresponding segment, with a dot representing fractions $\leq 5\%$. The upper red bar (where present) indicates the fraction of residues that have poor fit to the electron density. The numeric value is given above the bar.

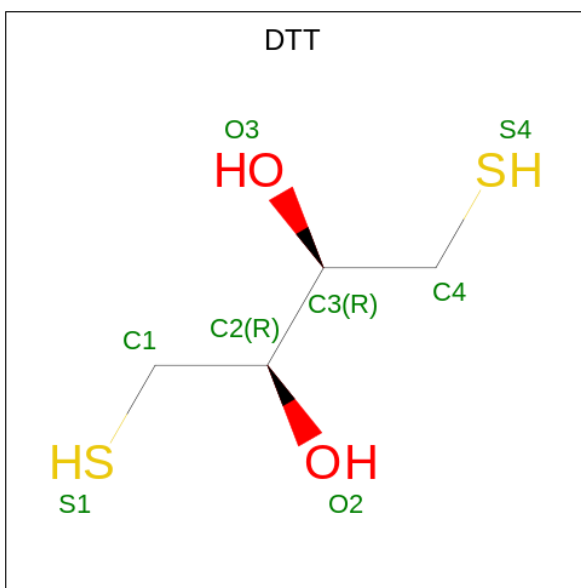
There are 8 unique types of molecules in this entry. The entry contains 12730 atoms, of which 0 are hydrogens and 0 are deuteriums.

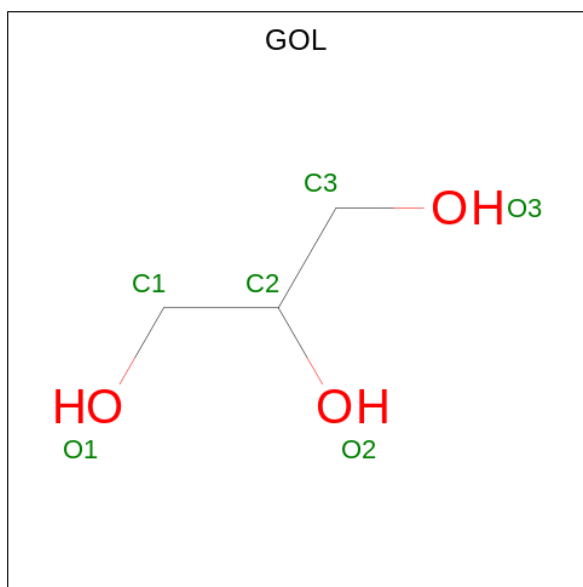

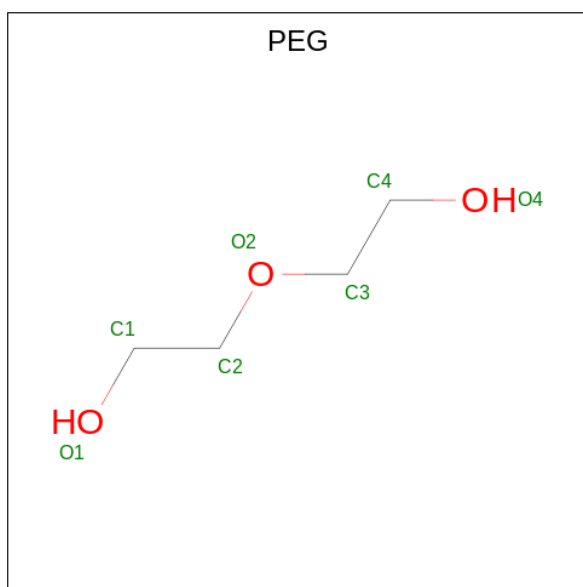

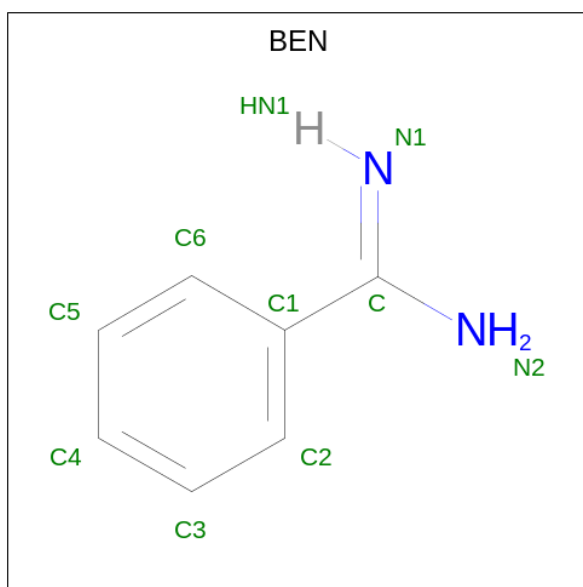

Xtrriage's analysis on translational NCS is as follows: *The largest off-origin peak in the Patterson function is 2.91% of the height of the origin peak. No significant pseudotranslation is detected.*
